



## **KMAN's "The Game" Announces Lineup Change**

Manhattan Broadcasting is proud to announce that NewsRadio KMAN's award-winning daily show "The Game" will debut a new lineup on Monday, Aug. 3rd.

Mitch Fortner will join longtime host John Kurtz as a co-host after seven years as the show's producer and update anchor, and Colin Settle will replace Fortner as producer.

"This is both a proud and exciting day for our show and the station," Kurtz said. "Mitch is incredibly deserving of this opportunity, and I think anybody that has listened to the show over the past six years is well aware of that fact."

Fortner has helped the show win seven Kansas Association of Broadcasters awards during that time - including back-to-back Medium Market Personality of the Year awards in 2017 and 2018. He has also garnered KAB honors for his work as a midday DJ on KMAN's sister station 101.5 KROCK.

"I'm thrilled to be able to further the success of our show in a more prominent role," Fortner said. "I'm confident that we will continue to push the show forward and build on the momentum that we have right now."

In addition to his duties at Manhattan Broadcasting, Fortner also serves as the play-by-play voice of Kansas State soccer and public address announcer for Kansas State men's basketball and select football games.

Settle has worked with the show in a part-time capacity since early 2019. He has earned multiple student awards from the KAB during his time at Kansas State University.

A two-time Oscar Stauffer award-winner, Kurtz maintains his role as the lead host of the show, which he has held since 2014. He has received 15 individual KAB awards for his work on "The Game" in addition to his responsibilities as a play-by-play broadcaster for K-State baseball, Big 12 Now on ESPN+, and K-State HDTV.

"The Game" airs daily from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. in Manhattan on NewsRadio KMAN (1350 AM/93.3 FM). The show is also available on Apple Podcasts, Google Podcasts, and Spotify.
